## PREFACE

1 Samuel ends tragically, with King Saul a virtual madman. He turns against David, his loyal servant and friend. He becomes paranoid, seeking to kill David as though he were a traitor. He fails to obey God's Word, and so brings about his own downfall and demise. Now, David will reign in Saul's place.

But, it doesn't occur quite this quickly, or easily. Thanks to the intrigue of men like Abner and Joab, Israel temporarily becomes a divided nation – a foreshadowing of future times for the nation Israel. Finally, David becomes king of all Israel. As he sets out to establish his throne, he seems to do everything well, and God's blessing is clearly upon him. However, there will be dark days ahead for David.

2 Samuel leaves us with an appreciation for the greatness of David, but also a realization of his human weaknesses. If there is to be a king who will dwell forever on the throne of David (2 Samuel 7:12-14), it must be one who is greater than David. If David is the best king who ever ruled over Israel, then God will have to provide, Himself, a better King. And so He will. This is a great book, one well worth our serious study. Let us look to God to work in our lives through our study of 2 Samuel.

Every effort has been made to remain true to the text. Questions are written to help the student read the exact words of the scripture without interpretive speculation. "Faith comes from hearing the message" (Romans 10:17) – not from man's "what do you think" or "how do you feel" about that message. Sometimes the student will be surprised, when examining the details; the story is not exactly what they have seen in a Bible video or simplified Bible class message.

Questions are based on the ESV® Bible (The Holy Bible, English Standard Version®). All questions are taken from the ESV® Text Edition: 2016, copyright © 2001 by Crossway, a publishing ministry of Good News Publishers.
