16. When she came to him, she urged him to ask her father for a field.			
17. And the people of Israel blessed God and spoke no more of making war against them to destroy the land where the people of Reuben and the people of Gad were settled.			
18. When your children ask in time to come, 'What do those stones mean to you?'			
19. A long time afterward, when the LORD had given rest to Israel from all their surrounding enemies, and Joshua was old and well advanced in years,			
20. And there Joshua apportioned the land to the people of Israel, to each his portion.
